MINUTES

Having been duly advertised as required by law, a Special Called Joint Meeting of Walterboro City Council and Colleton County Council was held at City Hall on Tuesday, August 26, 2008 at 5:00 P.M. The purpose of the joint meeting was to hold an executive session to discuss a legal matter on the Recreation Commission. Mayor Sweat and Colleton County Chair Dr. Joe Flowers jointly presided at this meeting.

PRESENT WERE: Mayor Charlie Sweat, City Council Members Randy Peters, Bill Young, Charles Lucas, Ted Parker, Franklin Smalls and Mary Anne Cannady. City Manager Jeff Lord, City Clerk Betty Hudson, and Attorney Tom Howard representing City Attorney George Cone were also present. **Colleton County Council Members present were:** Steven D. Murdaugh, Floyd Buckner, Gene Whetsell, Evon Robinson and Joseph F. Flowers, Chairman. Clerk to Council Ruth Mayer and County Administrator Doug Burns were also present on behalf of Colleton County.

There being a quorum present, Mayor Sweat called the meeting to order and called on Council Member Smalls for the invocation and Council Member Young to lead the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag.

At this point, Chairman Joe Flowers called the meeting to order for Colleton County Council and conducted a roll call. All members were present.

A motion was then made by County Council Member Steven Murdaugh, seconded by County Council Member Whetsell to enter an executive session with Walterboro City Council to discuss a matter related to the Recreation Commission. The vote on the motion was unanimous. Walterboro City Council then agreed by consensus, and the meeting convened into an executive session.

The meeting returned to Open Session with no formal action taken as a result of the Executive Session.

There being no further business to consider a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Young, seconded by Council Member Cannady and passed unanimously. The Mayor adjourned the meeting at 5:48 P.M. Notice of this meeting was distributed to all local media and posted on the City Hall bulletin board at least twenty-four hours prior to meeting time.
