AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF WALTERBORO, SOUTH CAROLINA, TO PROVIDE FOR CHANGES IN THE ZONING DISTRICTS OF THE CITY OF WALTERBORO BY CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF TWO FULL PARCELS AND ONE PARTIAL PARCEL OF LAND FRONTING MEADOW STREET, BETWEEN STATE AND TRINITY STREETS, DESIGNATED AS TMS#s 163-03-00-005, 163-03-00-014, AND 163-03-00-007 FROM MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL(MDR) TO HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL DISTRICT (HCD).

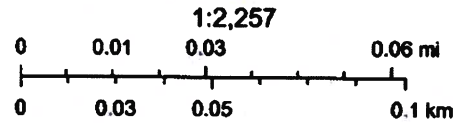

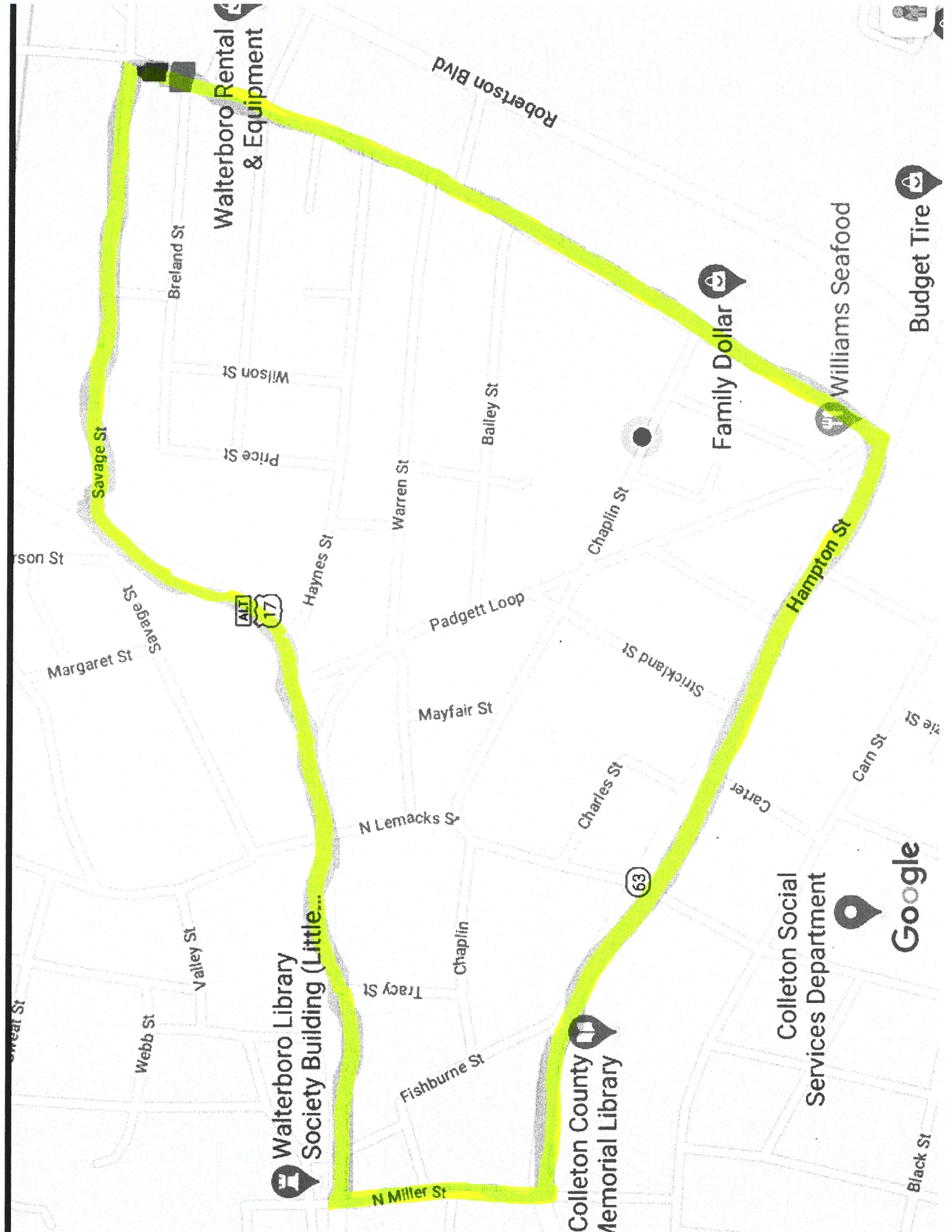

SUBJECT: East Side Water System Upgrade

The Utilities Department received bids from nine (9) contractors on June 30, 2020, for the construction of the East Side Water Distribution System Upgrade project. There were also bids on three (3) alternate items of work. The project entails the construction of approximately 7,000 linear feet of new 6" water mains to replace existing small diameter water mains located along Barracada Street, Live Oak Street, 6th Street and Hickory Street. The project will increase the volume and pressure of the water supplied to the surrounding area and will enhance fire protection capabilities.

The City's engineer, Hybrid Engineering has evaluated the experience of the bidders and found the low bidder, Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC (Branchville, SC) to be qualified and capable of performing the project. Hybrid Engineering recommends that a contract be awarded to Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC for the base bid plus Alternate Bid Item 1 and Alternate Bid Item 2 for a total contract price of **\$396,236.37**. Alternate bid item 3 (\$9,858.48) can be completed as a change order once an environmental survey of the area is completed. Staff recommends awarding the contract to Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC (Branchville, SC) in the amount of **\$396,236.37**. The City was awarded a \$487,500 CDBG grant for the project. City staff requests City Council's favorable consideration of the request. The City of Walterboro's Utilities Department accepted bids to upgrade the East Side Water Distribution System on June 30, 2020. The project consists of approximately 7,000 linear feet of new 6-inch water mains to replace existing small diameter water mains located along Barracada Street, Live Oak Street, 6th Street and Hickory Street. This project will increase both the volume and pressure of water supplied to the surrounding area as well as improve fire protection capabilities.

The City received bids from nine (9) contractors with a low base bid of \$348,067.84 and a high base bid of \$958,434.00. The certified bid tabulation is attached.

Our engineering representatives at Hybrid Engineering Inc. have evaluated the construction experience of the bidders and found that the lowest bidder, Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC has provided evidence of both experience and resources that would allow them to complete the project. We have also received bids on three (3) alternate items of work. With consideration of the alternate bid items, it is therefore staff's recommendation to award this construction contract to Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC for the base bid plus Alternate Bid Item 1 and Alternate Bid Item 2 in the amount of \$396,236.37.

The City of Walterboro received a Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$487,500.00 for the construction of this project.

As you know, the bid opening for the East Side Water Upgrade Project was conducted at 2 p.m. on June 30, 2020, at Walterboro City Hall there in Walterboro. There were 9 bids received and opened. A copy of the Bid Tabulation is enclosed. All bids were found to be responsive.

Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC., was the low bidder with a base bid price of \$348,067.84. We are of the opinion that this is a fair and reasonable price for this work. We have also received bids on three (3) alternate items of work.

Based on our review of their qualifications and consultations with references, we are of the opinion that Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC., is both qualified and capable of performing the East Side Water Upgrade Project. Accordingly, Hybrid Engineering, Inc. recommends that a construction contract be awarded to Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC. With consideration of alternate bid items and understanding the City's desire, Hybrid Engineering, Inc. recommends that a construction contract be awarded to Southern Fiber Construction & Management Co., LLC. for the base bid plus Alternate Bid Item 1 and Alternate Bid Item 2 at a Contract Price of \$396,236.37. We will be pleased, after City Council's consideration of this recommendation, to prepare and forward a Notice of Award for execution.






